El Santuario de Chimayó is a Roman Catholic church in Chimayó, New Mexico, United States. (Santuario is Spanish for "sanctuary".) This shrine, a National Historic Landmark, is famous for the story of its founding and as a contemporary pilgrimage site. For generations, American Indians, Hispanics, and other people of faith have traveled to the site of El Santuario to ask for ... El Santuario de Chimayo is now known (at least locally) as the "Our Lady of America." The crucifix still resides on the chapel altar, but for some reason its curative powers have been overshadowed by El Posito, the "sacred sand pit" from which it sprang, which gapes unevenly behind the main altar.
